

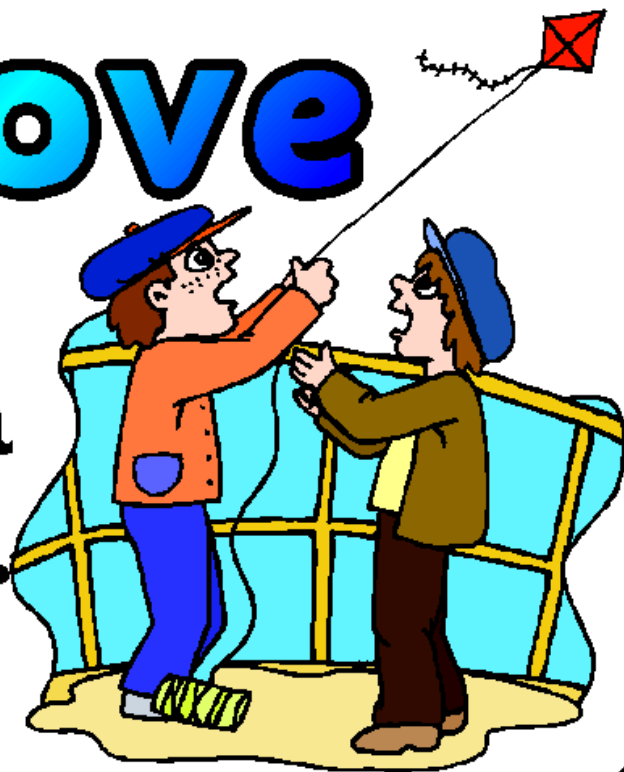
Prepositions

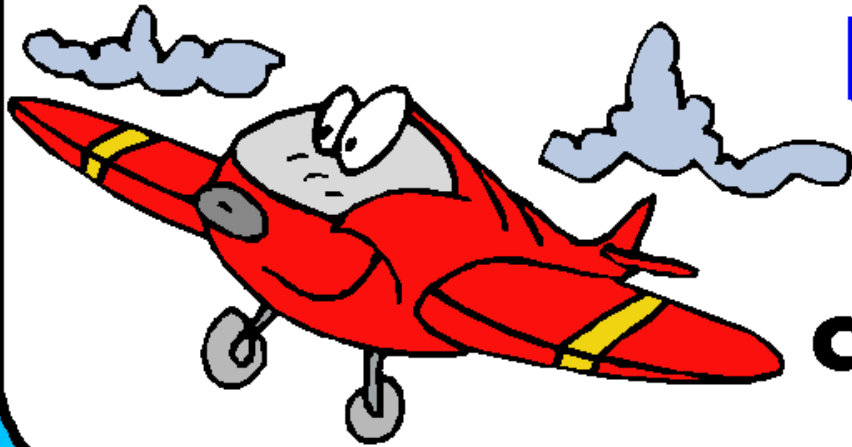

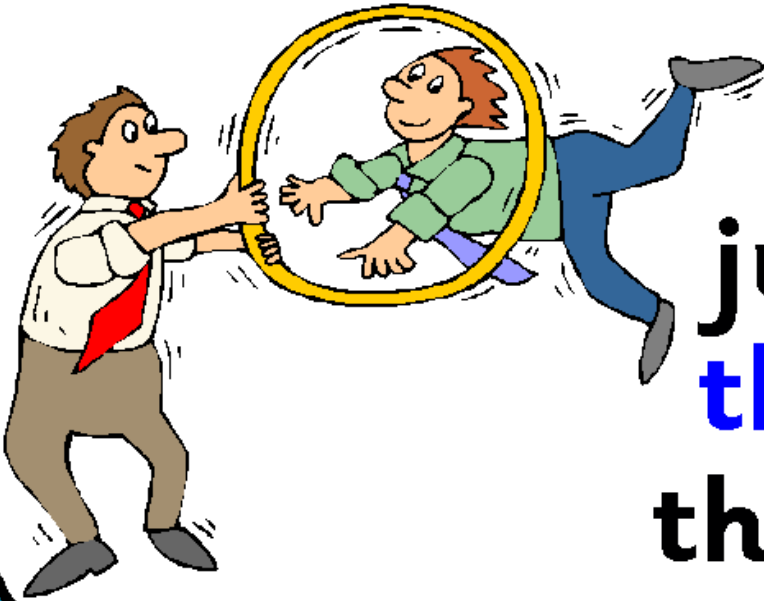

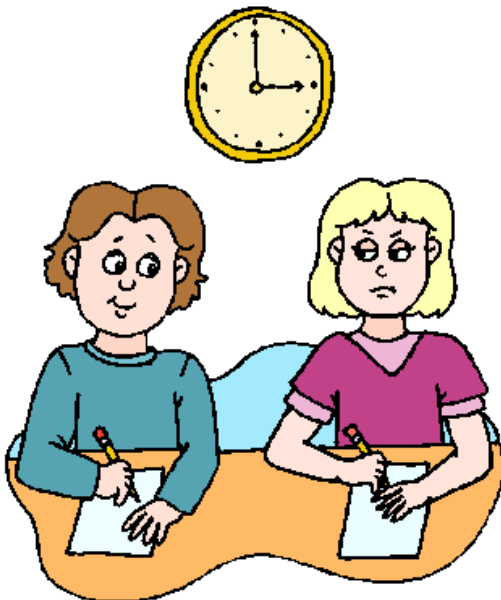
